EASTERN WOODLANDS	east of the Mississippi River to the Atlantic Ocean, from the Great Lakes to the Ohio River Valley	hot summers, cold winters, lots of rain	birch, maple, and oak trees, fish, wild turkey, deer, beavers, grass, rivers	Mohawk, Seneca, Delaware, Mohegans, Algonquin, Iroquois	
SOUTHEAST	south of the Ohio River Valley to the Gulf of Mexico, from Texas to the Atlantic Ocean	dry and wet areas, hot and humid	tall saw grass, deer, fish, fern, cypress, and palmetto trees, snakes, alligators	Choctaw, Seminole, Creek
