
CLASSROOM UPDATES

LITERACY

Non-Fiction Unit of Study

We will continue reading and discussing <u>Freedom Walkers</u>, a nonfiction book that highlights key figures in the Civil Rights Movement. Mini-lessons focus on vocabulary development, using text features, and identifying the different text structures of nonfiction writing like cause/effect, chronological order, problem/solution, and main idea/supporting details.

January Free Choice Novel

Students have selected a novel to read during the month of January. Students are expected to record a "Book Talk" on Flip by January 31. Directions for the "Book Talk" were sent home in backpack mail on Monday.

February Book Clubs/LMC Project

On Monday, January 29, students will be selecting a historical fiction novel to read throughout the month of February. Students will then be completing an analysis of the book during LMC that will involve research to determine which parts of the story were historically accurate and which parts were fiction.

Writer's Workshop: Writing Fiction

Students have begun the publishing process for this unit. This week they will be finishing their rough drafts. Next week, we will be working on revision assignments. Students look forward to sharing their work with you at Parent-Teacher conferences in a few weeks.

Unit 6: Volume

In this unit students will develop their understanding of three-dimensional figures and learn to measure volume and capacity of rectangular prisms and composite solids. There will be a test next week. Mrs. McLoone will be reaching out with details.

Unit 6: Integers

In this unit, students will describe quantities with positive and negative numbers, compare and order integers and absolute value numbers, and graph ordered pairs in all four quadrants of the coordinate plane. There is a Unit 6 test scheduled on Tuesday, January 30.
